Debris and Litter Removal	Keep area clean for aesthetics and prevent trash from ending up in creeks and rivers.	Routine – as needed by inspection, but no less than two times per year.
Sediment removal	Remove sediment from culverts, inlets, outlets to maintain function and flow capacity. Replace vegetation damaged in process.	Routine – as needed by inspection, but no less than once per year at culverts, inlets, and outlets.
Grass reseeding and mulching Seed Variety:	Maintain healthy grass or vegetative cover for both treatment and channel protection.	Non-routine – As needed by inspection.
Inspections	Check for adequate vegetative cover, trash and debris and sediment accumulation in swale, and ponding or mosquito habitat.	Routine – Inspections at least 3 times per year. Inspect outlet after a storm to make sure ponding and/or other mosquito habitat is not occurring.

Inspections	Check for adequate vegetative cover, trash and debris and sediment accumulation in swale, and ponding or mosquito habitat.	Routine – Inspections at least 3 times per year. Inspect outlet after a storm to make sure ponding and/or other mosquito habitat is not occurring.
